Glaucoma surgery



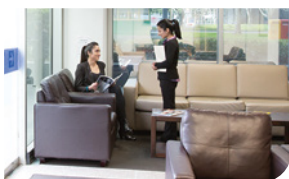

Before surgery

Pre-admission

Your surgeon will provide you with a Panch Day Surgery Centre information pack that will detail important information to help you prepare for your procedure. Please take the time to read the documentation and complete all pre-admission questionnaires prior to your arrival on the day of surgery. You will be contacted by a member of our staff the day before your procedure who will discuss your admission and discharge details.



On the day of surgery

Admission

What to bring:

- Your completed anaesthetic questionnaire
- Medicare card
- Health fund card
- Payment (if applicable)

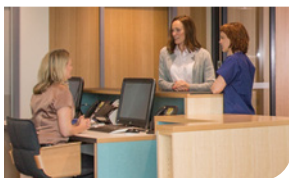


When you arrive on the day of your surgery, our administration staff will assist you with your initial admission and ask you to complete any outstanding paperwork or financial consent details before the nursing staff commence their clinical admission. The nursing staff will also inform your carer when you will be ready to be picked up.

After surgery

Discharge

Following your procedure, our nursing staff will monitor your recovery. If you have been fasting, you will be offered some light refreshments.



Once you are fully recovered, your carer will be able to join you. At this time, the nurse will provide you with written instructions regarding your post-operative care, dressings and follow-up appointments with your surgeon. You will also have the opportunity to discuss any questions or concerns you may have before you leave the day surgery.

Please ensure you follow the care instructions provided by the discharge nurse.

You will not be able to drive for 24 hours after your surgery and will be required to have a responsible adult drive or accompany you home. Patients will not be admitted to the day surgery if these arrangements cannot be made.

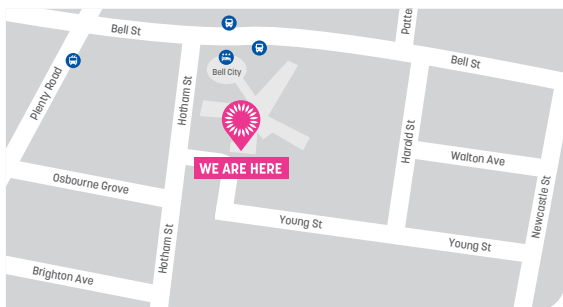




Our location

Panch Day Surgery Centre is located within the Bell City Complex, near the corner of Plenty Road and Bell Street. We are situated on Level 4 of the Corporate One building on Hotham St (look for the large chimney stack when you're driving down Hotham St).
